**Basic costs**

The following is the estimated cost for **one person** for **one year** of study at the College including 9 months of accommodation and living expenses. The living expenses assume a reasonably restrained lifestyle.

Please remember to add a return air fare *each year* if you are leaving family at home as we encourage overseas students to return home at least once a year.

The accommodation in College is either in single rooms or shared rooms, both with en suite facilities. The accommodation costs include gas and electricity charges, but exclude food and laundry. We are not able to offer accommodation for couples or families; accommodation in Glasgow would be approximately £400 per calendar month, but quite often does not include heating & lighting bills. We have a list of possible accommodation in and around Glasgow that you may find useful, but we have not checked any of them and we do not accept any responsibility for accommodation outwith the College.

Prices apply to 2011/12 and may increase in subsequent years.

**Accompanied by family**

College policy is that we strongly recommend overseas students do not bring their families with them. However, if your spouse and no children accompany you, then the costs increase by £400 per month for the first 9 months, which is the amount required by the UK Border Agency. If you come with children, then a further £400 for each dependant is required.
