

**International Christian College Costs of Study

Basic costs

The following is the estimated cost for **one person** for **one year** of study at the College including 12 months of accommodation and living expenses. The living expenses assume a reasonably restrained lifestyle.

Please remember to add a return air fare *each year* if you are leaving family at home as we encourage overseas students to return home at least once a year.

The accommodation in College is either in single rooms or shared rooms, both with en suite facilities. The accommodation costs include gas and electricity charges, but exclude food and laundry.

Prices apply to 2011/12 and may increase in subsequent years.

Accompanied by family

College policy is that we strongly recommend overseas students do not bring their families with them. However, if your spouse and no children accompany you, then the costs increase by approximately £400 per month. If you come with children, then approximately £250 per month should be added for the first child and £150 per month for each extra child. Couples or families will need to rent accommodation in Glasgow. We have a list of possible accommodation in and around Glasgow that you may find useful.
