Basic costs

The following is the estimated cost for **one person** for **one year** of study at the College.

Accommodation and a small weekly allowance are normally provided in most placements.

Please also remember to allow for a return airfare each year.

The costs of living above assume a 'reasonably restrained' lifestyle. Our experience is that many students from Europe wish to travel, take advantage of Glasgow entertainment opportunities etc, and may therefore require an extra £1,500 (approx.) on top of the stated costs.

It may be that you are eligible for grant/funding from your own Government agencies; you will need to make enquiries in your own country about this.

Accompanied by family

College policy is that we strongly recommend that overseas students do not bring their families with them. However, if your spouse and no children accompany you, then the costs increase by approximately £400 per month. If you come with children, then approximately £250 per month should be added for the first child and £150 per month for each extra child. Couples or families with children will need to rent accommodation in Glasgow as it is very unlikely that placements will be able to provide accommodation for families. This may well increase the costs. We have a list of possible accommodation that you may find useful.

The summer vacation

The programme runs from the beginning of September to June (with a graduation service during June in your last year). The placement continues through the summer break; annual leave is possible with prior arrangement.

Prices apply to 2011/12 and may increase in subsequent years.
